2.4	5. Transport – ASDA Community bus will start on 19 th May which is ASDA's opening day. And will be operated by Tates Travel Route affecting NFV will be St. Georges Road, New Forest Way, Sharp Lane. Tickets will be £1 adult day return.		FIO
	Other route changes will take effect from 1 st June Service 9 – To be re-routed between Middleton Ring Road and Sharp Lane via St. Georges Rd and New Forest Way. Service 87 - To serve ASDA / St. Georges Centre and in conjunction with 85 to double frequency to NFV / HV. Will run between Belle Isle & Ring Road Beeston via St George's Rd and Towcester Ave, Acre Road, Sissons Terrace & Bodmin Rd. Services 64/74/74A – Will run as circular services in both directions between Belle Isle and Middleton. 64 & 74 will both terminate at ASDA but a through service will be created so that passengers can travel from any section covered by 64 to any section covered by 74, and vice-versa throughout the operating day. This will be shown on the timetables to aid public understanding. This will essentially provide the through link between Middleton and Raylands/Belle Isle on the 74 which has been a long term aspiration. Service 64 will run from ASDA via Ring Road Middleton, Middleton Park Road, Thorpe Road, Thorpe View, Throstle Road, Middleton Park Avenue and current 74 route (74A evenings and Sunday daytime) in both directions to Leeds City Centre, extending to Aberford via the current route. This service will no longer serve Sissons Rd or Sissons Terrace. Service 74 will run from ASDA via New Forest Way, Sharp House Road		

	<p>to Sharp Lane and the current route into Leeds City Centre extending to Gildersome via the current 64 route. This will improve service provision in the Sharp House area.</p> <p>Together with 85/87 this will provide a 15min service during Monday to Saturday daytime from Stourton Grange/Belle Isle to ASDA & St. Georges Centre.</p> <p>Route and timetable information for the First Bus service changes will be available on Metro's website in May www.wymetro.com.</p> <p>Cllr Dunn expressed concern that little consideration had been given to residents living on Thorpe Lane and agreed to contact ARRIVA to request that the 487 be diverted to include a stop at ASDA</p>	Cllr Dunn	UNM
