Minutes of last meeting – Tuesday, 20th May, 2014

Items for discussion at this meeting:

- Notifications:
 - Tom Smith, change of role. Has asked his replacement to nominate a colleague to attend these meetings
- Transport:
 - Buses not taking correct route through NFV
 - Size of buses through NFV
 - Asda lorries coming through St George's Road
 - Markings on roundabout next to Asda
 - 24hr opening of Asda and concern about lorry deliveries – noise
 - No official bus stop coming from Leeds/Seacroft – only on Sharp Lane & St George's
 - Stop at Fenton Gate should be both directions
- Police:
 - Congregating youths after hours in Asda car park
 - 'Boy racers' in Asda car park on a Sunday
 - Smell of 'cannabis' in flats on Fentons
 - Red, Seat Leon – YB06 HRP – caught doing 'handbrake turns' on New Forest Way (07-07-14) and is also being antisocial in their parking on Willow Dale
 - Congregating youths on Plantation – on path alongside beck, top pond and litter bin – suspicious behaviour observed by dog walkers
